Topic: For being a better game teaching!!

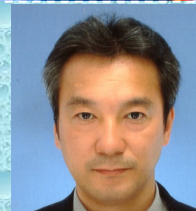

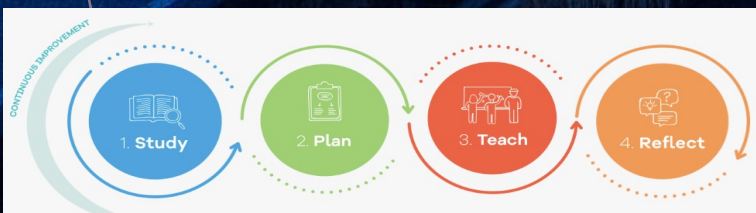
